Who will attend?

This weekend is designed to explore and resolve personal issues that are interfering with your ability to live life fully. It is suitable for participants new to psychodrama and those experienced in the method.

What is Psychodrama?

A group action method which uses directed dramatic techniques to explore and resolve issues raised by participants. From group interaction a protagonist will emerge to enact the theme of the group. Auxiliaries, chosen by the protagonist from the group, will take part in the protagonist's drama. The director will use psychodrama techniques of concretization, maximization, mirroring, doubling and role reversal to enable the drama to unfold. At the conclusion of the drama the participants will share their experience with the protagonist to integrate the session.
